

Clara Lieu was an Adjunct Professor at the Rhode Island School of Design from 2007-2020, where she taught in the departments of Foundation Studies, Printmaking, Painting, and Illustration.

She is the founder and owner of Art Prof Projects LLC, an educational platform for learning visual arts. Lieu specializes in remote teaching and learning and has done faculty training for the Massachusetts College of Art & Design, Framingham State University, and several public school districts.

Lieu has written for the New York Times, lectured widely at Brown University, Simmons College, the California Art Education Association, the National Art Education Association conference, and in Vancouver and China. Her work has been profiled on WBUR, Artsy, Hyperallergic, Inside Higher Ed, WCVB's Chronicle, and KPCC.

Lieu has received artist grants from the Massachusetts Cultural Council, the Berkshire Taconic Community Foundation and the Puffin Foundation. Her work has been exhibited at the International Print Center New York, the Danforth Museum of Art, the Currier Museum of Art, and the Davis Museum and Cultural Center.
